The beach and amusement piers serve as backdrops for a day of learning and fun. In the morning, students participate in one of six unique educational workshops offered 9:30am–10:15am or 10:30am–11:15am, followed by an afternoon of fun on Morey's Mariner's Landing amusement rides and Raging Waters waterpark. Raging Waters is open from 10am–5pm; amusement rides from 11am–5pm. Education Extravaganza is designed for students from Grades 3 through 12.

### **NEW FOR 2009 → Science Exploration**

Science comes alive during this new interactive workshop. Students will have the unique opportunity to see how science plays a part in our everyday lives. *Grades 5-9*
