Job Opportunities

- **RIDE OPERATORS:** Individuals in this position operate the controls of the ride. Ride Operator Certification is provided on-site.
- **LIFEGUARDS:** Team members work outdoors in our aquatic areas and have high guest interaction. Lifeguard Certification is provided on-site.
- **FOOD SERVICE:** Work in stand alone carts or fast food restaurants. Jobs include cooks, servers and cashiers.
- **GAMES:** Games range from spinning wheels to basketball shots to water pistol races. Team members must be outgoing and vocal.
- **ADMISSIONS:** This position has many functions, including cashiering, processing sales transactions, handling tickets and Season Passes and taking guest comments.



Morey's Piers provides a training program for all employees that focuses on safety and exceptional guest service.

Uniforms

All employees must provide themselves with at least two pairs of tan-colored, cotton shorts and/or pants; a belt; and a closed toe, flat heeled athletic shoe (sneakers, trainers) by the first day of employment.

Morey's Piers provides lifeguards with a bathing suit, t-shirt, visor and whistle. Lifeguards must provide themselves with sunglasses by the first day of employment.

Hours and Compensation

We are open from late March through Mid-October, however our main season extends from mid-June until mid-September. The amusement parks are normally open from noon until after midnight. The waterparks are open from the end of May until the beginning of September. Normal operating hours for the waterparks is 9am to 7pm. Scheduling varies and is flexible.

Employees earn an hourly wage plus a seasonal bonus. Wages are paid on a weekly basis in the main season (June – September) and are paid bi-weekly during pre- and post-season. Due to the fact that we are an industry for the public, we do not offer overtime pay, employees are paid the flat hourly rate regardless of the number of hours worked per week.

Finding Housing

Housing is independently owned and operated. Morey's Piers has relationships with area housing owners and supplies a list of available housing.

The types of accommodations are typically apartments (flats) and rooming houses. It will be your responsibility to make arrangements for housing. We will make every reasonable effort to assist you in your housing efforts.

RENT

Housing costs vary depending on several factors: location, arrival date and type of housing.

Rent is usually paid weekly. Expect to be required to pay a security deposit (usually one weeks rent) and your first week's rent upon arrival.

STANDARD OF LIVING

Most housing in Wildwood is adequate. It can most accurately be compared to cheap college/university housing. You will want to find a safe, clean, conveniently located place, but keep in mind you won't spend much time there so it doesn't need a lot of extras. Do not expect to walk into flats with air conditioning, satellite TV, and pools out back. (although there are a few places with these amenities). Accommodations are furnished and usually provide bed linens and cooking supplies.

International Employees...

The Jersey Shore

Wildwood is located in New Jersey and is actually a barrier island renowned for its sparkling white, expansive beach. The Wildwoods have a population of approximately 15,000; in the summer that number increases to almost 500,000. Wildwood is conveniently located and is close to many other large cities:

New York City, New York	3 hours	125 miles (201 km)
Philadelphia, Pennsylvania	1.5 hours	72 miles (116 km)
Washington, D.C.	3.5 hours	118 miles (191 km)
Baltimore, Maryland	3 hours	99 miles (159 km)
Atlantic City, New Jersey	45 minutes	33 miles (54 km)
Delaware (tax-free outlet shopping)	1.5 hours	30 miles (49 km)

Once you arrive you will find that it is easy to get around. Everything you will need (grocery stores, laundry facilities, restaurants, shopping, nightlife and clubs) is within walking distance of your accommodations and work. The only time you will need to use public transportation is when you travel outside of Wildwood. There are lots of activities in the area including fishing, sailing, water skiing, boogie boarding, surfing, jet skiing, volleyball, tennis, basketball, golf, biking, whale and dolphin watching, and much more. Shopping is available as well as sight-seeing in historic, Victorian Cape May.
